Ribbons will be displayed only on winning quilts at the show. There will be no indication on non-ribboned quilts to show that they were judged. All entries will receive critiques which will be available at the hostess station at the show or with the Guild Show Representatives after the show.

Judging Categories – Please select the best one for your quilt. The committee and judge reserve the right to place your quilt in a different category based on professional knowledge and number and distribution of entries.

- Duet – 2-person quilts such as quilt tops done by one person and quilting by another
- Group – (made by 3 or more people) such as friendship group, round robin or presidents' quilts
- New Quilter – (5 or fewer finished quilts) may be professionally quilted, must be noted
- Art Quilt – Pictorial
- Art Quilt – non-Representational
- Pieced/wall quilt Small – Perimeter 72 inches or less – self-quilted
- Pieced/wall quilt large – Perimeter between 172 inches and 288 inches – self-quilted
- Pieced/bed quilt – Perimeter 288 inches or more – self quilted
- Applique – hand or machine, will be evaluated on how well the chosen technique was executed
- Modern Quilt – quilts that meet the accepted definition of a modern quilt in style and execution
- Mixed Technique – A significant amount of appliqué & piecing (not just sashing and/or border)
- Miscellaneous – Embroidery (machine), red work, trapunto, Christmas tree skirt, etc.
- Comments Only – this is for quilters who would like the judge's comments on any quilt that is not going to be entered into the current year's show

There is a non-refundable fee of **\$10** for each judged entry. Checks **ONLY**.
