


SEVEN SISTERS QUILT SHOW - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

LOCATION INFORMATION

- A - bathrooms
- B - security table where volunteers get name tags, also lost and found and first aid
- C - hostess table where you can pick up your judging results and sponsored awards
- D - food court
- E - water fountain
- F - ATM in lobby
- G - viewers' choice ballot boxes
- H - view and vote for challenge quilts and wearables
- I - location of raffle drawings and viewers' choice ribbon awarding
- W - waiting areas
- Y - youth quilt display



Q. Where can I find a **(SPECIFIC VENDOR)** booth?

A. Show them in the program how to find if the vendor is here, the number of the booth, and where that is located from the map.

Q. Where would I find _____ Guild's **OPPORTUNITY QUILT**?

A. Refer them to the Information Table where there is a a map showing opportunity quilt locations.

Q. I am looking for a specific quilter's **QUILT**. How do I find it?

A. Show them in the program how to find the quilter alphabetically, and how to find the bay with his/her quilt from the map. Point out that each bay is numbered with a white flag.

EXIT INFORMATION

Q. How do I get out?

A. You may leave either through the large glass doors at the front of the quilt display area, through the front doors by Security table or through the tent the way you came in.

Q. How do I get the van to my car?

A. There is a pick-up area outside near where you came in at the front of the tent.

TIME/LOCATION OF DRAWINGS

Q. When and where is the announcement for Viewers' Choice and the drawing for the Information Table Raffle?

A. Sunday afternoon at 3 p.m. in the entry to the lobby.

Q. When and where is the drawing for the Sponsorship Raffle Baskets, fabric cakes, etc.?

A. Saturday at 4 p.m. and Sunday at 3 p.m. in the entry to the lobby.

Q. When are the Challenge Quilt and Garment ribbons awarded?

A. Sunday afternoon at 3:15 p.m. in the entry to the lobby.

Q. When are the drawings for opportunity quilts?

A. This is different date for each quilt as set by the individual Guild. Visit each booth to learn about their individual drawing dates.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Q. Why doesn't this great quilt have a ribbon?

A. Not all quilters choose to have their quilt judged; it may not have been the best in its division (such as small pieced quilt); sometimes a quilt looks great, but the judge finds technical problems with the way it was made.

Q. Do you have quilts for sale?

A. Yes. There is a booth in the tent. In addition, some quilters are willing to sell the quilts on display. If they are, it will say so on the card attached to the quilt.

Q. What is an opportunity quilt?

A. An opportunity quilt is a quilt being raffled by a guild to support their educational and charity efforts. Usually opportunity quilts are made by several members of the guild working together rather than by one individual.

Q. How can I become a vendor at this show?

A. You may contact anyone from the vendor committee to assist you (they are wearing red aprons).

Q. When can I pick up my quilt and take it home?

A. Individual quilters may not enter the main building to obtain their individual quilts. All Acquisitions committee members who are there to take the quilts back to their individual guilds must stay within the main building until every single quilt has been returned to its proper guild and all guilds agree they have all their quilts. At that point, one of the Quilt Show Co-Chairs will announce that Acquisitions may leave the building with quilts. Individuals may only get their quilts from the Acquisition committee members outside the building after they have been cleared to leave.
