## SEVEN SISTERS - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### LOCATION INFORMATION

Q. Where are the **BATHROOMS**?

A. There are bathrooms in the lobby and the back corner of the building (show on map).

Q. Where is **LOST AND FOUND**?

A. In the lobby at the Security table

Q. Where is **FIRST AID**?

A. In the lobby at the Security table

Q. Where can I get my **RESULTS FROM JUDGING**?

A. In the lobby at the Hostess table

Q. Where can I get some **FOOD/DRINK**?

A. The Food Court is in a tent behind the building accessed through a door in the back wall.

Q. Is there a **WATER FOUNTAIN** available?

A. There is one fountain at the back next to the bathrooms.

Q. Where is the **ATM** located?

A. An ATM can be found in the Lobby just to the left of the glass doors.

Q. Where can I **SIT DOWN** to rest? or Do you have a husband **WAITING AREA**?

A. There are three areas of chairs in the main building: near the tent entry, near the exit directly across from the tent entry, and in the back near the bathrooms. There are also chairs in the food court.

Q. Where is (**SPECIFIC VENDOR**) booth?

A. Show them in the program how to find if the vendor is here, the number of the booth, and where that is located from the map.

Q. Where can I find the **CHALLENGE QUILTS OR GARMENTS**?

A. There is a small room off the Lobby to the right with both Challenge Quilts and Garments.

Q. Where do I **VOTE FOR THE CHALLENGE QUILT** and/or **GARMENT**?

A. You will find a small table with ballots and ballot boxes next to the entrance to the room with the Challenge Quilts and Garments.

Q. Where do I put my **VIEWERS' CHOICE BALLOT**?

A. There are ballot boxes at the entry to the tent, the Information Table, and the exit near the front of the building.

Q. Where would I find \_\_\_\_\_ Guild's **OPPORTUNITY QUILT**?

A. Refer them to the Information Table where there is a map showing opportunity quilt locations.

Q. I am looking for Suzie Q's **QUILT**. How do I find it?

A. Show them in the program how to find the quilter alphabetically, and how to find the bay with his/her quilt from the map.

## EXIT INFORMATION

Q. How do I get out?

A. You may leave either through the large glass doors at the front of the quilt display area, through the front doors by Security table or through the tent the way you came in.

Q. How do I get the van to my car?

A. There is a pick-up area outside near where you came in at the front of the tent.

Q. Where do I get my bus to go home?

A. Buses are asked to pick you up at the exit on the side near the front of the main building.

## TIME/LOCATION OF DRAWINGS

Q. When and where is the drawing for Viewers' Choice?

A. Sunday afternoon at 3 pm at the entry to the lobby.

Q. When and where is the drawing for the Raffle Baskets?

A. Saturday and Sunday afternoon at 3 p.m. at the entry to the lobby.

Q. When and where is the drawing for the Summer's Splendor raffle quilt?

A. Sunday afternoon at 3 p.m. at the entry to the lobby.

Q. When are the Challenge Quilt prizes and Garment ribbons awarded?

A. Sunday afternoon at 3:15 pm at the Challenge Quilt display.

Q. When are the drawings for opportunity quilts?

A. This is different date for each quilt as set by the individual Guild. Visit each booth to learn about their individual drawing dates.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Q. Why doesn't this great quilt have a ribbon?

A. Not all quilters choose to have their quilt judged; it may not have been the best in it's division (such as small pieced quilt); sometimes a quilt looks great, but the judge finds technical problems with the way it was made.

Q. Do you have quilts for sale?

A. Not at this time, perhaps in the future. However, some quilters are willing to sell the quilts on display. If they are, it will say so on the card attached to the quilt.

Q. What is an opportunity quilt?

A. An opportunity quilt is a quilt being raffled by a guild to support their educational and charity efforts. Usually opportunity quilts are made by several members of the guild working together rather than by one individual

Q. How can I become a vendor at this show?

A. You may contact anyone from the vendor committee to assist you (they are wearing red aprons)

Q. When can I pick up my quilt and take it home?

A. Individual quilters may not enter the main building to obtain their individual quilts. All Acquisitions committee members who are there to take the quilts back to their individual guilds must stay within the main building until every single quilt has been returned to its proper guild and all guilds agree they have all their quilts. At that point, one of the Quilt Show Co-Chairs will announce that Acquisitions may leave the building with quilts. Individuals may only get their quilts from the Acquisition committee members outside the building after they have been cleared to leave.
